Siphe November, Principal Dancer of the National Ballet of Canada, is not only the first and top ballet dancer in Canada. He is also a street dancer, a movement model, a performer, a choreographer, and he also composes music and plays piano. These are his other talents and passions, which together with his creativity and charisma, makes a complete global and unique artist, who attracts attention at first glance.

Also his story is unique and impressive. He is originally from a little town in South Africa, where he used to dance in the streets with his brothers. How he achieved to become the youngest number one Principal Ballet Dancer in the National Ballet in Canada, is such an inspiring story, that has been made into a documentary-film: "Beyond Moving". "It's a Billie Elliot story with a South African twist" (Toronto Star), with the difference that this is a real story with a real protagonist, a beyond talented South African 11 years old boy.

One of Siphe's goals is to create a platform that facilitates young black South African talents to be also discovered, so they can have the same opportunities he had 10 years ago.

The film *Beyond Moving* shows how Siphe's charisma and dance passion were formed early on while growing up in Zolani, a farming community two hours east of Cape Town. As many other young boys in town, he was dancing in the streets a dance-style called Kwaito, a variant of house music and local African rhythms that first gained popularity in Johannesburg in the 1990s. Those beats determined his passion and changed the course of his life: "When you are performing dance in South Africa," Siphe says, "it's all about the feeling, about creating a presence, and bringing people into your world."

Siphe's ability to fuse the immediacy of African vernacular dance with the precision and elegance of classical ballet sets him apart. His clean moves in ballet are also so defined as a street dancer. That's why he had the chance to become a professional movement model in Canada: his extremely clean and defined moves command attention, they are really visual and attractive to the audience's eye. His talent is really exclusive and unique.



Siphe November is the Principal Ballet Dancer of the National Ballet of Canada. He grew up in Zolani, a little town in South Africa where he used to dance in the streets with his brothers. His extraordinary talent was spotted by a Canadian family, who organised and sponsored his trip to Toronto to an audition in a dance school. Now, 10 years later, he is the Principal Dancer of The Nacional Ballet of Canada (NBC). The youngest in the company and the only black Principal dancer in the National Ballet Company. His story, commitment and effort far from his family is so impressive that has been made into a documentary-film: "Beyond Moving" starred by him.

Siphe November is also a Choreographer, Movement Model and Performer. Beyond ballet, he is starting to introduce his exquisite work in several projects with other artists and media; and in advertising by collaborating with brands that share his same message and values.

He is also actively promoting a bridge between Africa and developed countries to make it easier for African talents to get the same opportunity he had. Because, as he says "talent is everywhere but opportunities are not".
